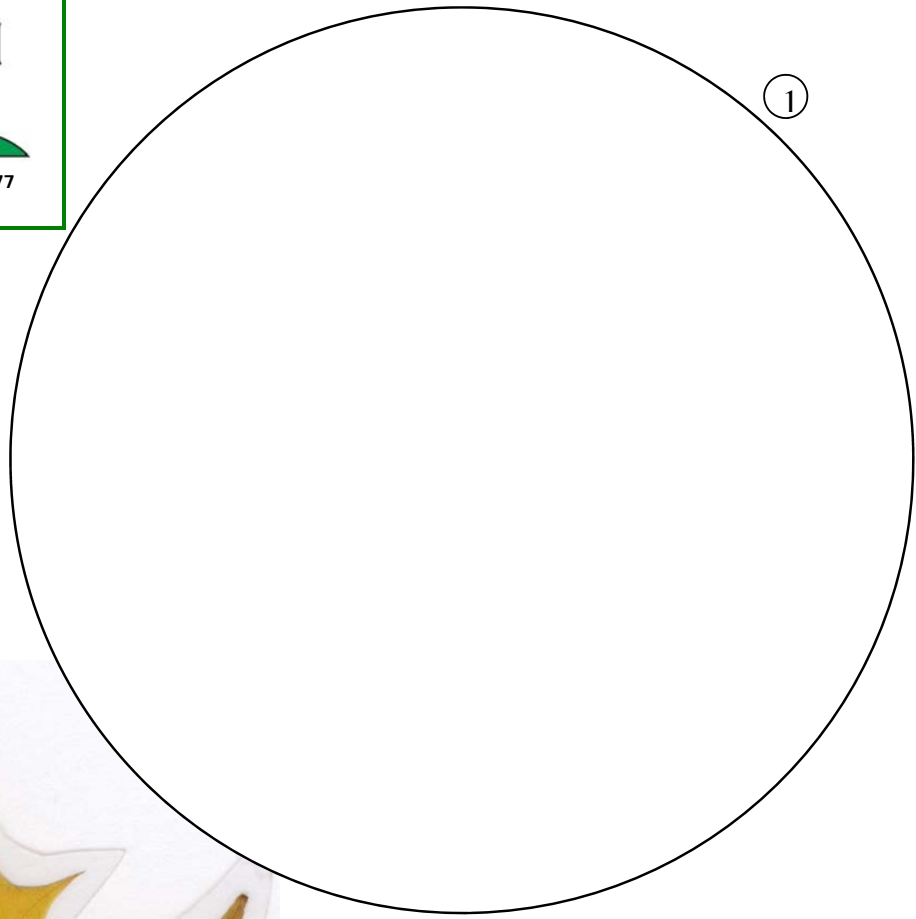




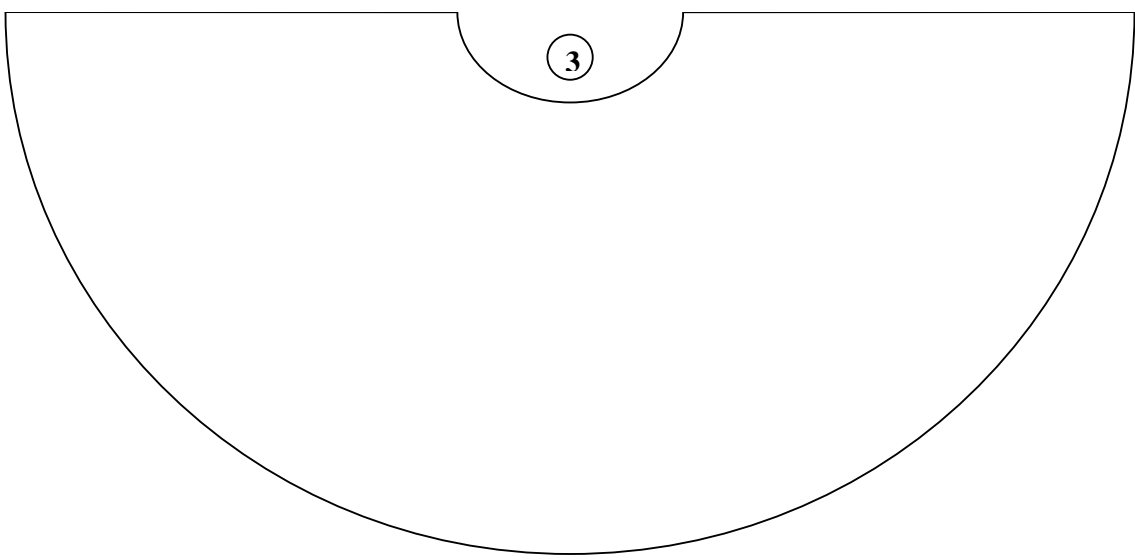

Maple Leaf Christmas Angels



This is a quick Christmas activity for those harassed souls who need to occupy de-mob happy little dots for a couple more days and fancy a bit of peace on Earth!

Maple Leaf Christmas Angels: Instructions



Cut out the two shapes and the leaf.

A. Roll up one or two of the offcut pieces into a tight ball, about the size of a large marble. Place it in the middle of circle (1) and twist to encase the ball, forming a head and fanned-out shoulders.

B. Lay head and shoulders on semicircle (3) and wrap around to form a cone-shaped body. Secure with sticky tape.
NB: Use cellulose based tape such as sellotape to be environmentally friendly - it's biodegradable!

C. Put a line of glue down the centre of the leaf (2), on the printed side, from the middle to the bottom and attach it to the cone, covering the sticky tape so that it looks neat!

That's all there is to it! The angel will perch on the top of the tree or you could attach a wool or ribbon loop to the back of the wings to hang it up.

TIP: To extend the activity or if you fancy making a bit more mess, the angels' dress can be decorated either before or after assembly with glitter, sequins or cut out pieces of paper doily! If you are feeling really adventurous, you could make a halo from fuse wire or a glittery pipecleaner and attach it with a blob of PVA glue.
